Environment Agency defences are shown with a standard of protection which is against a 20% AEP event or more. Man-made and natural defences which may arise, for instance due to the presence of naturally high ground adjacent to a settlement, have been considered. Formal structural defences are given a rating by the Environment Agency based on a grading system for their condition from very poor to very good. There were no defences in the study area with a rating of very good or very poor. The ratings are defined below:

- Very Good** - Cosmetic defects with no effect on performance.
- Good** - Minor defects that will not reduce overall performance.
- Fair** - Defects that could reduced performance.
- Poor** - Defects that would significantly reduce performance.
- Very Poor** - Severe defects causing complete performance failure.
