Frequently asked questions

Q. What does Exclusive Right of Burial mean (EROB)?

A. It means you are purchasing the right to be buried in a plot for 50 years, you do not own the land which remains the property of the local authority. For underground burial chambers the maximum lease period is 99 years.

Q. What happens when the lease ends?

A. You may extend the lease on a burial plot for a further 50 years for the fee applicable at that time. For underground burial chambers the lease may not be extended beyond 99 years.

Q. Can anyone pre-purchase a plot or underground burial chamber?

A. Pre-purchase is limited to residents of Crawley.

Q. How many burials/interments can take place in a plot or underground burial chamber?

A. You may inter four sets of cremated remains in a cremation plot. Each grave space is large enough to hold two full coffined burials plus four sets of ashes. Two full burials are permitted in an underground burial chamber. Each plot in the Muslim section is single depth only.

Q. Can I choose my plot?

A. No, Crawley Borough Council will allocate the plot at the time of purchase. If it is not possible to allocate a plot you will be guaranteed a burial in your preferred cemetery.

Q. Do I have to pay a deposit for the EROB?

A. Yes, the cost to pre-purchase the Exclusive Right of Burial is the fee applicable at the time of purchase.

Q. Can I sell my plot?

A. A pre-purchased plot is non-transferable. The owner is not permitted to transfer the plot to a third party.

Q. Will I need to pay additional fees at the time of the first interment?

A. Yes, at the time of the first interment you will pay the digging fee plus any increase in fees for the EROB between the purchase date and date of first interment.

Q. Can I place any memorabilia or planting on my pre-purchased plot?

A. No, the plots will remain as turf until the first interment takes place.
