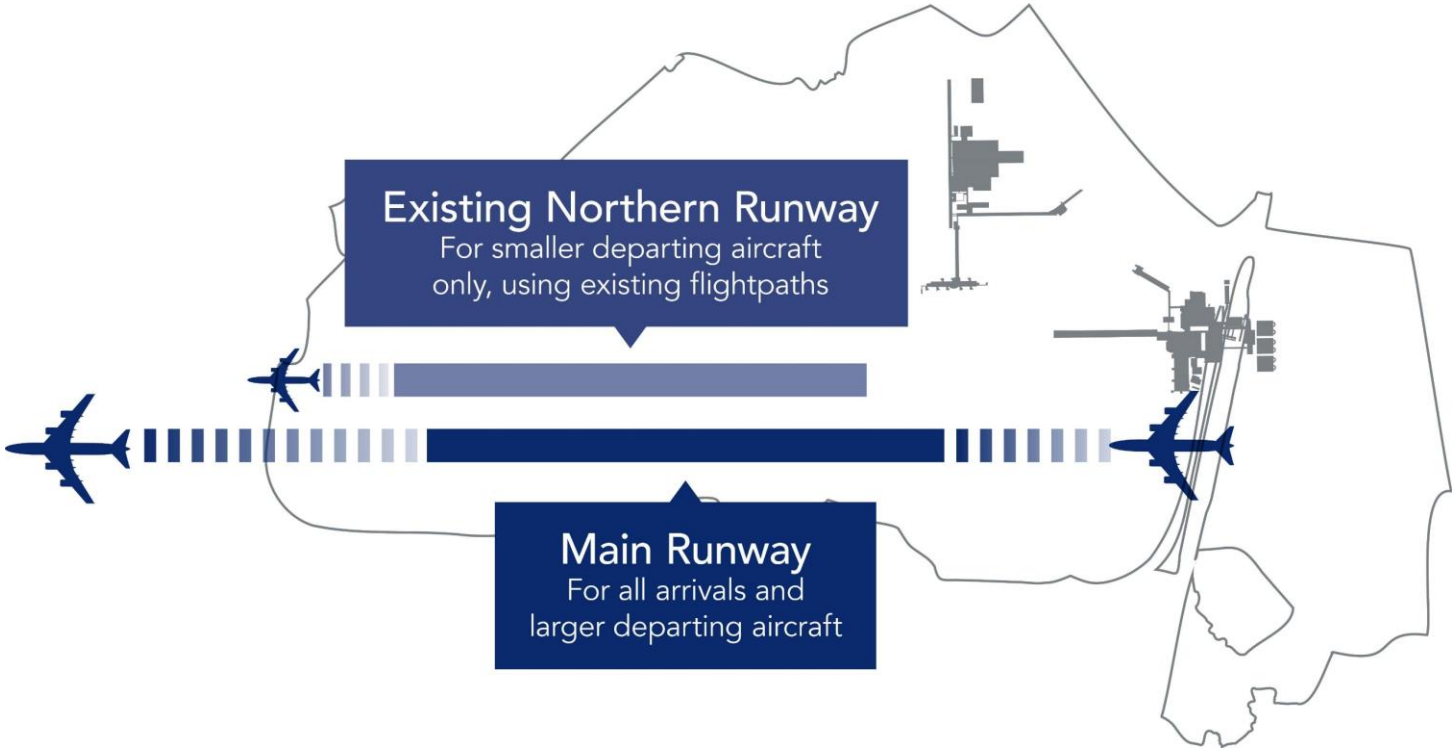

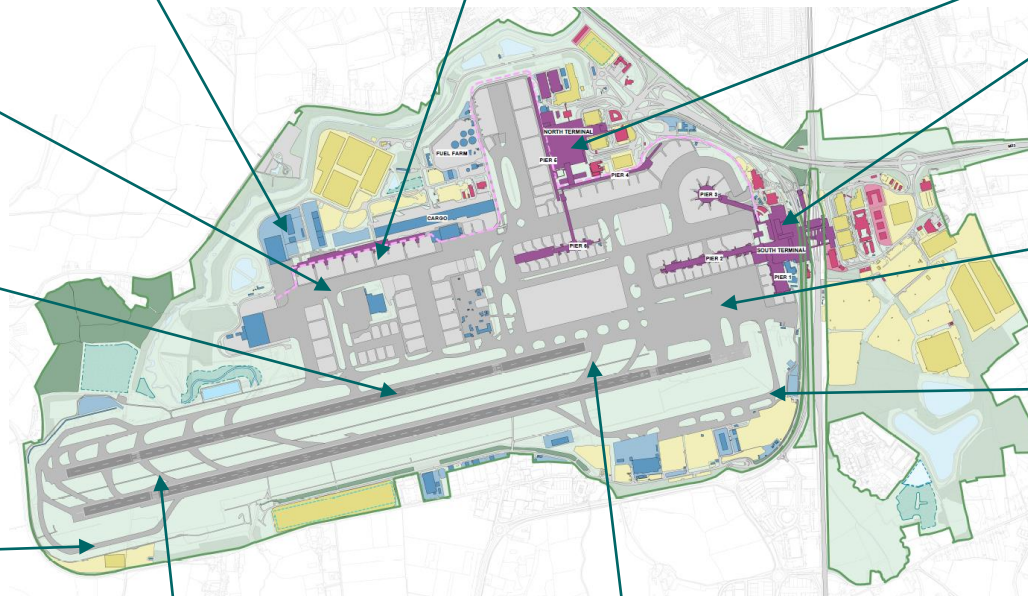

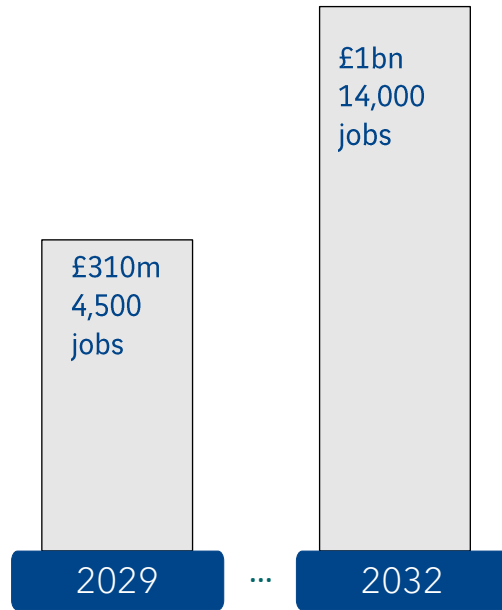


ALL THIS NEW INFRASTRUCTURE WILL BE WITHIN THE EXISTING AIRPORT BOUNDARY

Road improvements – additional capacity and separation of local from airport traffic



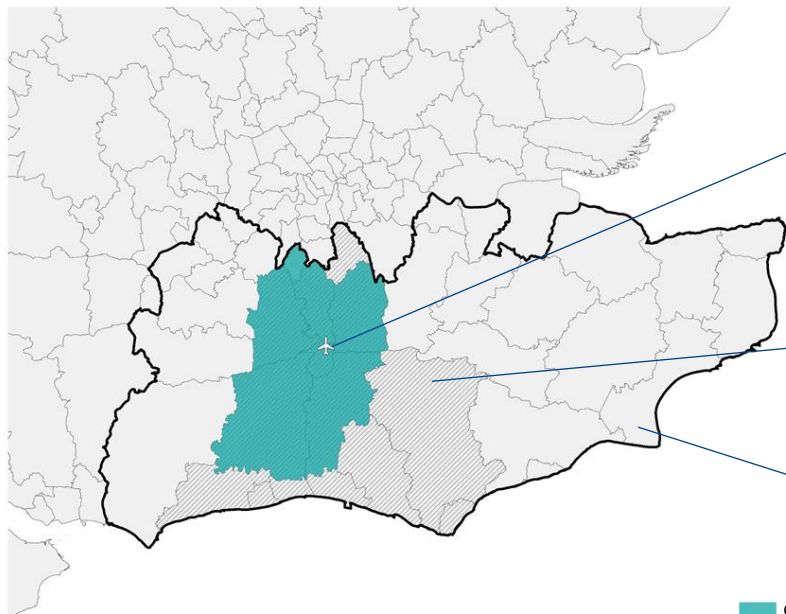
NRP employment and GVA impact



- The Project is expected to generate **significant economic benefits** in terms of employment and value.
- A large share of these benefits are expected to occur in the **local area around the airport** (Six Authorities Area).
- By 2032, the Project would generate **14,000 jobs and £1bn** in Gross Value Added within the Six Authorities Area, of this:
 - **1,793 jobs would be generated in Crawley** (resident-based)
 - **£125.7m GVA would be generated in Crawley**

Estimates correspond to the Six Authorities Area. All local impacts included (direct, indirect, induced, and catalytic)

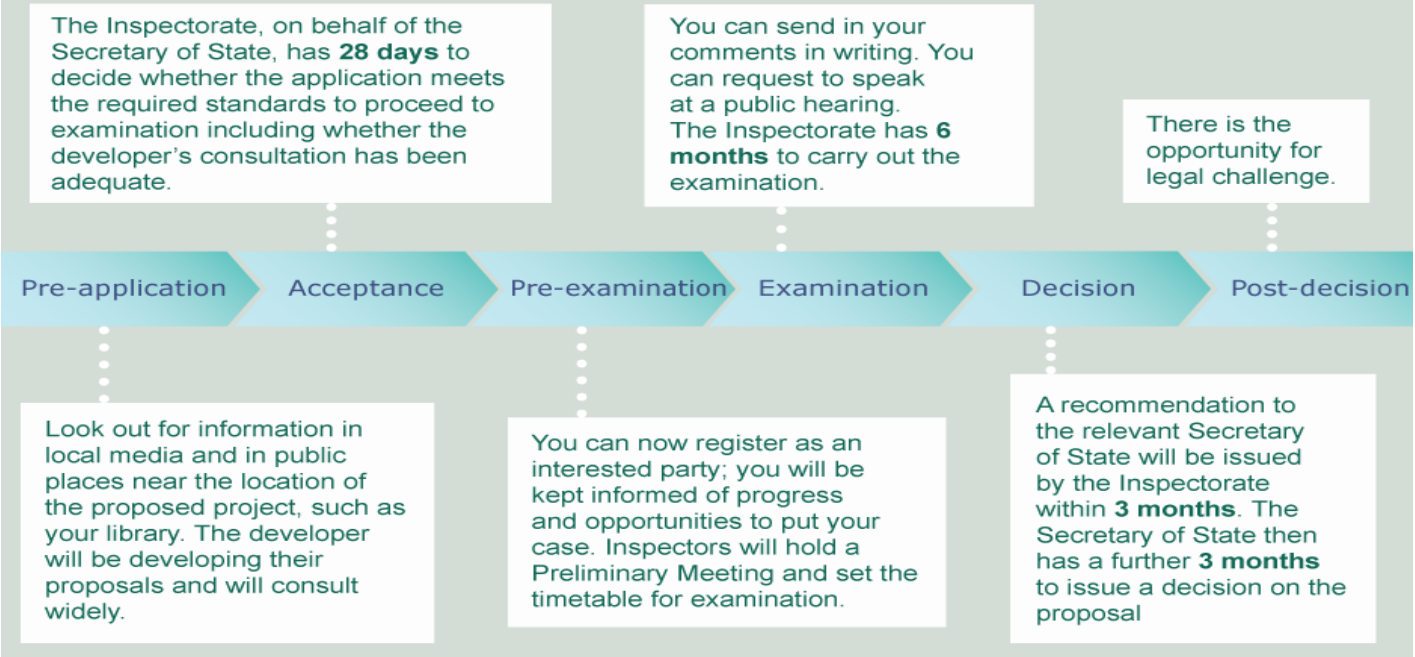

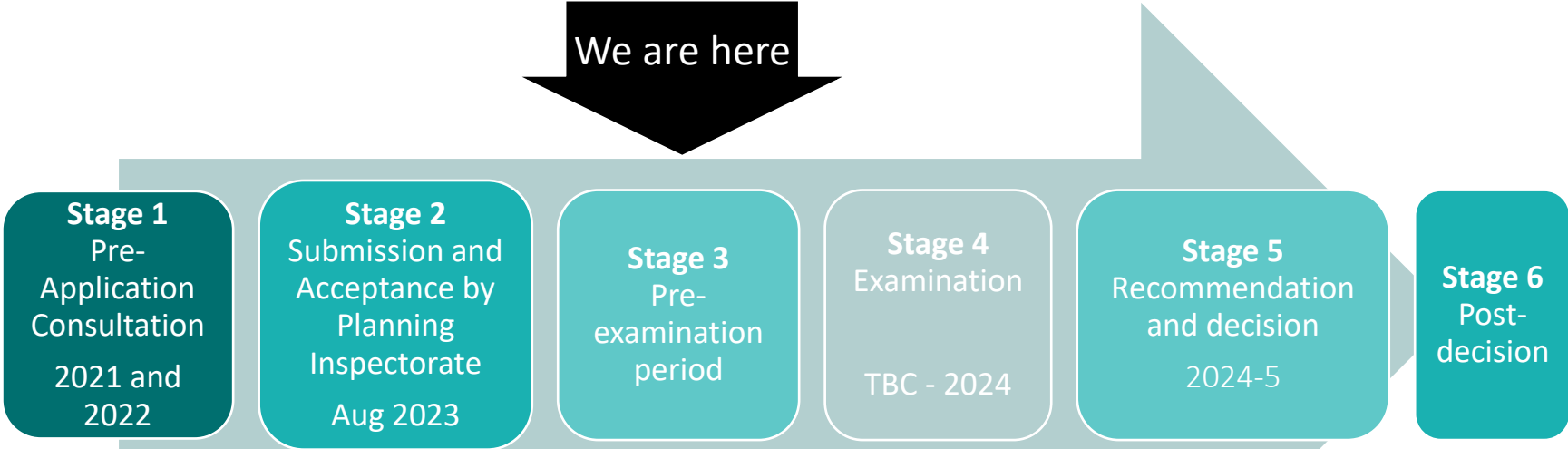
- PINS accepted GAL's application on 3 August 2023 triggering a number of activities
