Thank you for sending the heritage appraisal in relation to the above site. In our original letter dated 10th November 2014 we set out the process which we considered need to be undertaken to be able to fully appraise the impacts of the proposal on the significance of the grade I listed church and on the conservation area. We are satisfied that the proponents of this site have now carried out this process and we do not feel we can add anymore to our original comments in relation to impacts on the setting of the grade I listed church.
